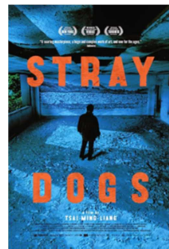

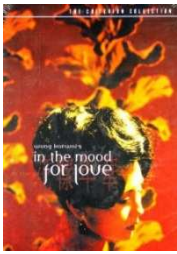

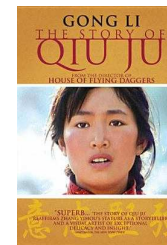

Chinese Zodiac



The Chinese Zodiac, known as *Sheng Xiao*, is based on a twelve-year cycle. Each year in the cycle is related to an animal sign. These include the rat, ox, tiger, rabbit, dragon, snake, horse, sheep, monkey, rooster, dog and pig.
